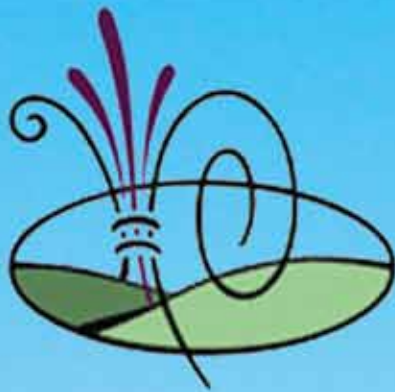

Roger A. McEowen is the Leonard Dolezal Professor in Agricultural Law at Iowa State University in Ames, IA, where he is also the Director of the ISU Center for Agricultural Law and Taxation. Before joining Iowa State in 2004, he was an associate professor of agricultural law and extension specialist in agricultural law and policy at Kansas State.

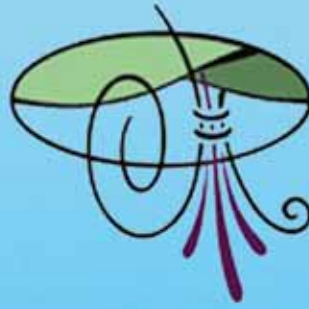
